Cook County Farm Bureau Ag-in-the-Classroom program offers a week-long comprehensive training seminar for teachers in Cook County. SAI 1 provides the tools and knowledge necessary to understand the complex and fascinating industry of agriculture.

Throughout the week, teachers visit commodity organizations and agribusinesses, receive a bus full of **FREE** classroom materials, and participate in hands-on activities they can easily integrate into their classroom learning.

Summer Ag Institute is based out of the Farm Bureau Building in Countryside. Teachers will meet every morning for tours and workshops and then return to their home each evening.

Summer Ag Institute offers teachers the opportunity to earn **35 CPDU's or 3 Graduate Level Credits**.

The cost of the Institute is \$250 (includes complimentary membership) for non-farm bureau members and \$225 for current members. However, each teacher who attends all five days and completes the required paperwork will receive a **\$200 stipend!** Graduate credits will be an additional cost, approximately \$300.
