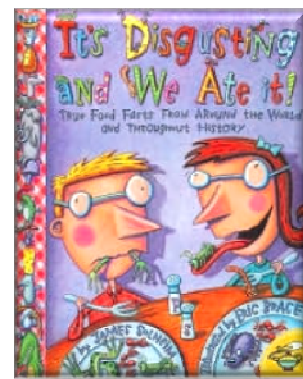
## Spring 2012 Workshops
